A letter from Edna Yang, Co-Executive Director

Happy Thanksgiving! We were grateful to hear the news about <u>Title 42 being struck down</u> by US District Court Judge Sullivan. From its inception, Title 42 was based on disingenuous public health rationales and tired old racist tropes that associated immigrants and disease. The program effectively denied the more than 1.8 millions individuals and families fleeing violence and persecution the ability to seek asylum in the U.S. as is their right under federal and international law.

This decision only further highlights the need for comprehensive immigration reform. Our current system is broken - no one can argue with that. We need permanent and sensible changes to our outdated immigration laws to ensure that the dignity and human rights of immigrants are recognized.

As always our staff continues to provide the necessary information, advocacy, and representation needed to all of the communities we serve. Our goal is to give some help – some hope – to every immigrant who comes to our door, because everyone deserves to understand the law, know how to follow it, and gain legal representation, if needed. Everyone deserves access to justice, and everyone deserves to have their humanity recognized and be treated with dignity.
